

Quotes informer designer user's guide

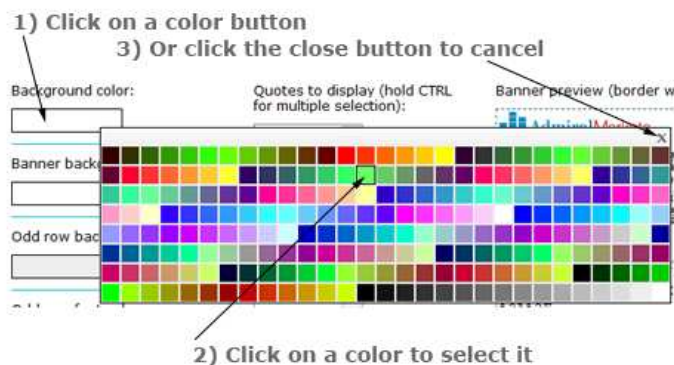
With the help of our quotes table informer, your visitors can see the latest bid/ask values for the quotes you choose to show. You can generate a table of one or more quotes and place it on your webpage. The informer (quotes table) will be auto updated on a selected interval so your visitors will know the latest bid/ask values without refreshing the page. It works just like a simple banner, except you have to configure it before adding to your webpage. Our quotes informer designer allows you to choose the informer style: colors, fonts, quotes to be displayed etc. All you have to do is adapt the informer design to suit your web interface and add your referral URL. The designer will generate some HTML code that you have to insert to webpage. Note: depending on the page you're using the designer from, its interface may slightly differ, but the base concepts remain the same.

Configuring the way your informers look

Here's a couple examples of informers you can generate with our designer interface:

As you can see, the interface of the informer can be adapted to almost any interface. On the designer's page you can see some input fields and color buttons. Input fields are used to define some textual or numerical values and the color buttons select colors for various parts of the informer. To select a color for a specific part of the informer, click on the color button. The color picker dialog box will appear under the mouse cursor. You will then be able to click on the color you wish to use:

- 1) Page background. Affects the color of the entire banner's background. If you're using a cell spacing of more than 0, this background color will be visible through the gaps between the table cells.
- 2) Banner background. This is a color for the top part of the table that has our banner.
- 3) Header / footer background. Affects the background color of the table's header and footer.
- 4) Arrow style. You can choose from a few predefined arrow styles to suit your informer's design.
- 5) Header / footer background. See no. 3.
- 6) Background for odd rows. This is the color for the rows, that cannot be equally divided by 2 (1, 3, 5 etc.).
- 7) Background for even rows. This color defines the background for the rows that can be equally divided by 2 (2, 4, 6 etc.)

Besides the mentioned colors there's also font colors for the same informer areas.

Configuring additional settings

Besides the colors and styles you'll also find some input fields you need to fill in or select values from. These fields are:

- Banner width. Defines the width of the banner in pixels.
- Banner height. Defines the height of the banner in pixels. Depending on the font size and quote count you choose, you'll need a different height to fit all the content in the informer.
- Cell spacing. Defines a gap in pixels between the table cells.

- Referral URL. Your full referral URL, including the http:// part.
- Refresh interval. This is a data update interval in minutes. The informer will auto-refresh itself in the interval you specify. The minimum interval you can specify is 1 minute.
- Font size. Defines the overall document font size.
- Font. Lists some predefined fonts you can use.
- Quotes text. This text will be displayed in the table's header over the "Quote" column.
- Bid text. This text will be displayed in the table's header over the "Bid" column.
- Ask text. This text will be displayed in the table's header over the "Ask" column.
- Quotes to display. You can select multiple quotes to be displayed in the table. Note: the more quotes you select – the bigger the banner will get in height. You will need to adjust the height property to make the table fit in the banner.

Finalization

After you've finished the configuration, copy and paste the HTML code from the text box below the banner to your webpage.
